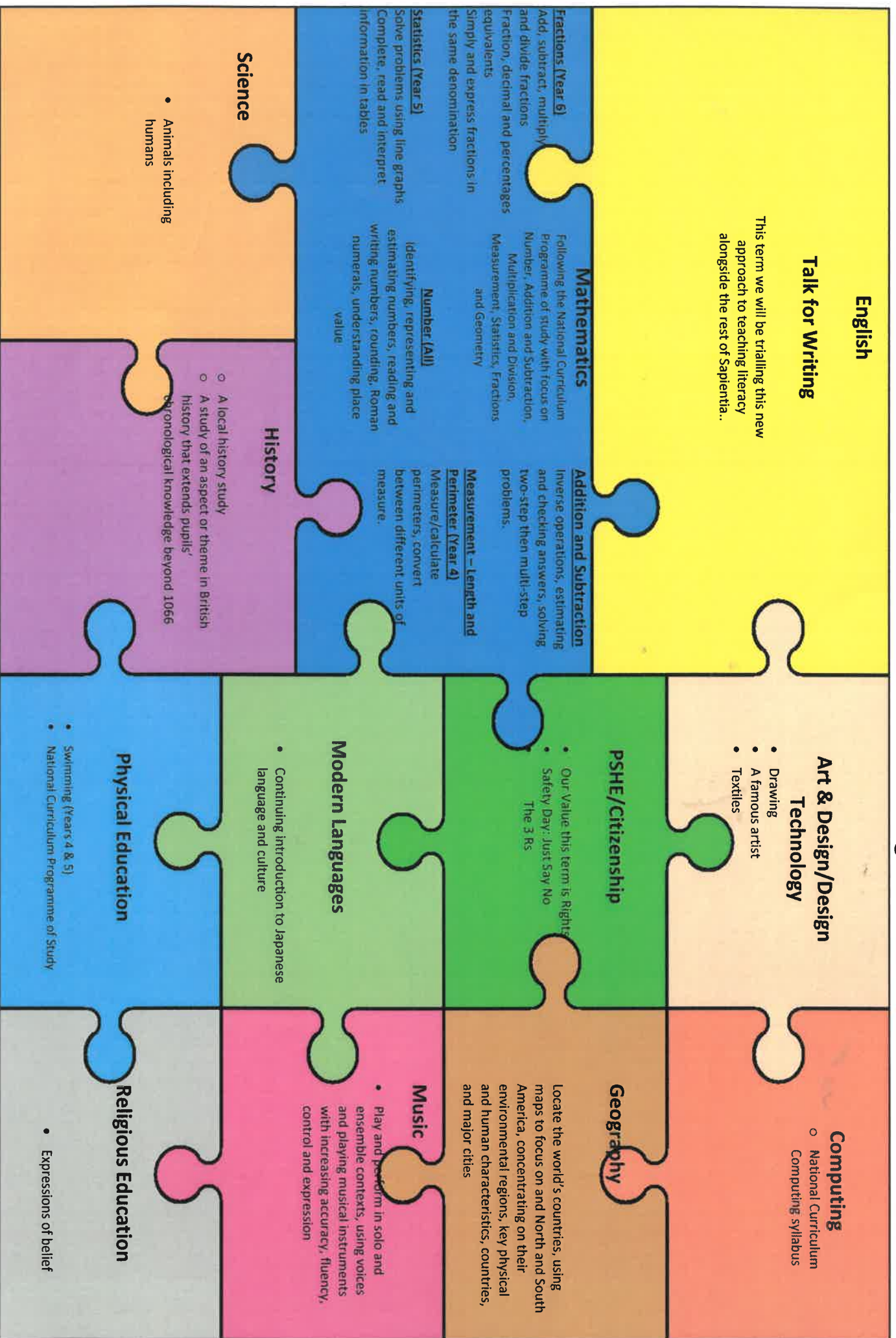


**Class 2 Autumn term 2013 –

Fractions (Year 6)

Add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions
Fraction, decimal and percentages equivalents
Simply and express fractions in the same denomination

Number (All)
